



- Appraisers have different education requirements for different levels of licensure






Active MI Appraiser Count by State

3175 Active Appraisers (As of 2022)




Active Appraisers in Metro Detroit (Tri-County Area)






Active Appraisers by Zip-Code (Detroit)





- Diversifying workforce and enforcing fair lending practices




Literature Reference



- Utilized over 32 million appraisals between 2013 and 2021
- Based on 2022 Uniform Appraisal Dataset (UAD) released by Federal Housing Finance Agency (FHFA)
- White neighborhoods appraisal value = <u>double</u> the value of comparable homes in communities of Color nationally



Publications + Other Findings



Home Appraised With a Black Owner: \$472,000. With a White Owner: \$750,000.

Nathan Connolly and his wife, Shani Mott, say an appraisal company undervalued their home based on their race. The couple has filed a lawsuit in Maryland.




