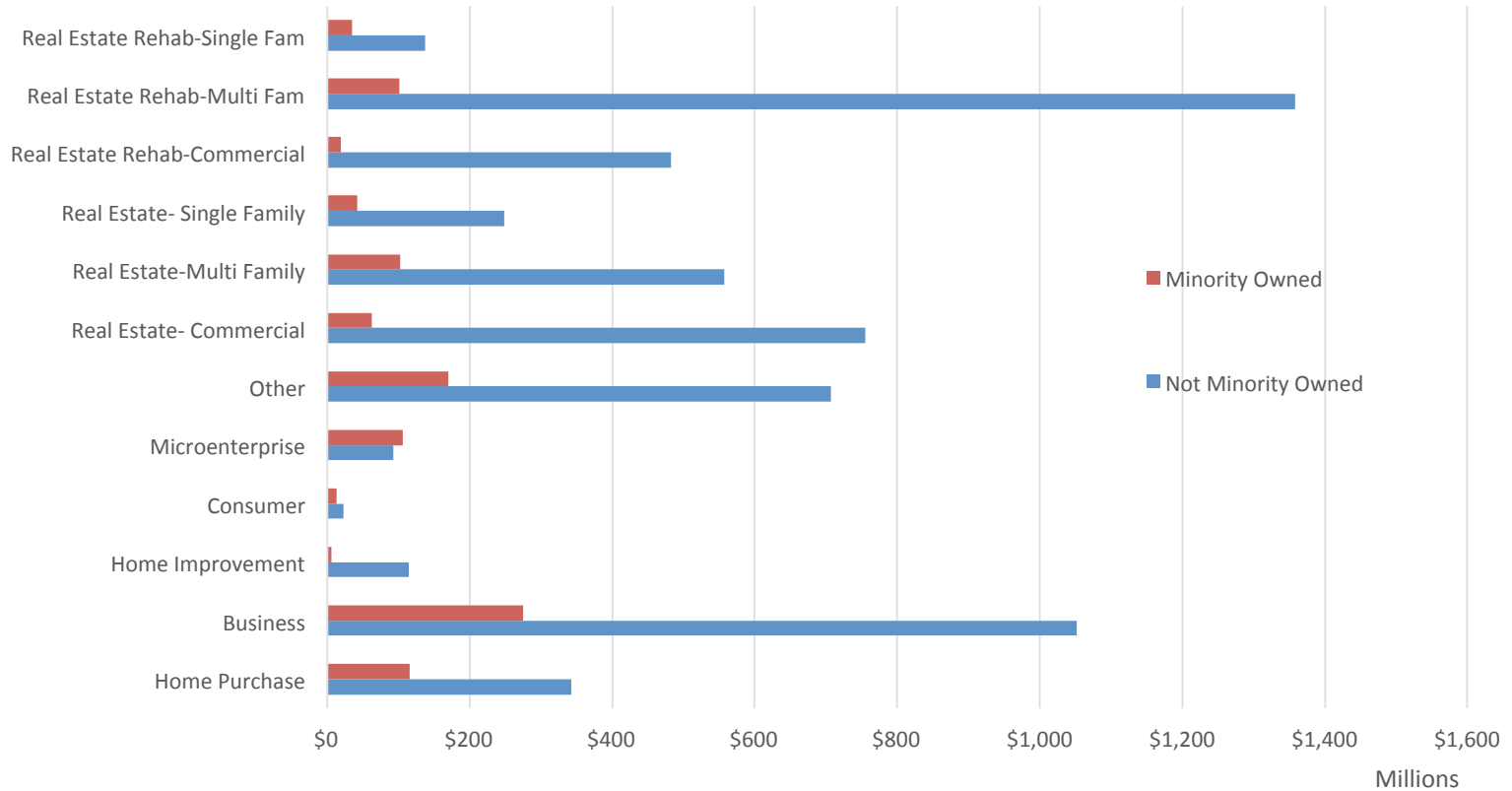
To summarize, minority owned or controlled CDFIs account for:

- 31.4% of reporting CDFI loan funds
- 31.7% of total jobs created/maintained by reporting CDFI Loan Funds
- **15.% of total assets** of reporting CDFI loan funds
