

RACIAL WEALTH SNAPSHOT

DEMOGRAPHICS

Asian American is a racial category that includes Americans who are from or whose relatives are from a diverse group of countries. Within this diversity of Asian American nationalities we see a diversity of economic outcomes.






2018 annual median income of Asian Americans reached \$87,194, which is 38% greater than the national median income of \$63,179. Yet nationalities like the Burmese have an annual median income 43% lower than the national average.

POVERTY RATES


Despite Asian Americans having the highest household median income,
